

Summer 2024 Internship Job Description

We desire to be a part of the change in our community to ensure that all community members have access to fresh, local, nutritionally dense foods. We operate a 25-acre farm that grows produce according to sustainable agricultural principles. We donate over half of our production to hunger relief in our region and sell the remainder into the larger food system to further stimulate the region's growing farm-to-table movement. Last year, we were able to donate over 20,000 pounds of fresh produce to our community.

Intern(s) will assist with hosting volunteer groups that include individuals, businesses, and churches. Additionally, interns will help with the development and outreach side of a nonprofit, including donor relations, social media, and community engagement.

Responsibilities will include:

- Assisting the outreach team with:
 - Marketing, community engagement, and volunteers
- Assisting the development team with:
 - Donor relations, fundraising, and event planning

Position Requirements:

- Strong communication skills
- Social media knowledge
- Works well with different people (personalities, abilities, and backgrounds)

- Has a passion for feeding NWA

This Summer internship will be held May-August. The internship is *unpaid*, but you do get to take home fresh produce! Interns are responsible for their own transportation to Cobblestone Farms or the designated program location. Interns must comply with US laws as well as Cobblestone Farms rules and regulations. An ideal candidate would have Friday mornings free to participate in hosting volunteer groups.
